Manuel Göttsching & AshRa "In Concert"

After 12 years Manuel Göttsching & AshRa are back on stage in Berlin with Harald Grosskopf on drums and Steve Baltes contributing electronics. For their forthcoming concert Göttsching, Grosskopf & Baltes will be playing a mix of old and new material on the summer stage of the ufaFabrik. This venue is of historical significance for AshRa and Correlations as it was here in 1978 where the band rehearsed for this album. The artwork was supplied by the UK design team Hipgnosis, famous for their Pink Floyd, Genesis and T.Rex sleeves. The recordings were mixed by Mick Glossop (producer of John Lee Hooker, Zappa and Van Morrison) and released on Virgin Records. "I had been using rhythmic tape delays before working with AshRa," recalls Glossop, "but it was Manuel who introduced me to the use of ,dotted time', which produces much more interesting rhythmic patterns and was used later to great and popular effect by U2's guitarist The Edge. Once again, Manuel was way ahead of the times!" - Göttsching made music history and is regarded as the key figure of Psychedelic & Cosmic Rock and of Minimal Music.
